

# BIG CAT CHEETAH TUMBLER



## **MATERIALS**

CCX 110 Tall Travel Cup
Detail Brush
Liner Brush
Fan Brush
Cheetah Patterns
Straight Pin

## **COLORS**

CMM 39 - Blue Green CMM 73 - Safari CMM 31 - Licorice




### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Use your fan brush to apply 2 coats of Safari to the outside of the mug.
- 2. While that is drying, cut out your cheetah patterns.
- 3. When the yellow is dry we can apply the cheetahs. Working one at a time, dip a paper cheetah in water and put it on the cup, smoothing out any air bubbles.
- 4. Repeat until your desired number of cheetahs are on the cup.
- 5. Paint one more layer of Safari on top of the paper patterns to make sure they're sealed down.
- 6. Once the yellow is dry, use your fan brush to apply 3 layers of Blue Green on top, covering the outside.
- 7. When the background is dry, but the cheetahs are still shiny, use a straight pin to remove the cheetahs.
- 8. Using the photo as a reference, apply the details to the cheetahs using a detail brush and Licorice paint. We just did one coat.
- 9. Finally, if desired, use your detail brush and Licorice paint to apply doodles on the background around the cheetahs. We did leaf shapes.

#### **TIPS**

- When you remove the paper patterns, don't pick at the edge with the pin. Instead, poke the paper about 1/4" from the edge and scoop upward to release it.
- Just one coat of paint is necessary on the doodles.
