

DRIPPING ROSE WINE GLASS

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB37200 Wine Glass Medium Brush Fan Brush

COLORS

EL-127 Rose Granite Elements
EL-133 Autumn Elements
EL-140 Toasted Almond Elements
PC-601 Clear Cascade



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use your fan brush to apply 2–3 coats of Toasted Almond to the stem and base of the glass (we only did 2 coats on the underside). Allow the glaze to sweep upward onto the bottom 1/4 of the top part of the glass.
- 2. Apply Rose Granite to the top of the glass, leaving the top 1/2" unpainted. Allow the Rose to sweep down and overlap with the Almond above the stem.
- 3. Use your medium brush to tap on a layer of Clear Cascades to the top 1/2" of the glass, allow it to make small drips.
- 4. When the Clear Cascades are dry, tap on a layer of Autumn on top.
- 5. Finally, paint the inside of the glass with 3 coats of Autumn.

TIPS

- Be generous with the paint to ensure proper coverage.
- All the white needs to be covered with the glaze.
- The colors create a new dynamic color where they overlap, so allow the colors to overlap slightly where they meet.
